# **Native Shoreland Planting Operation and Maintenance**

Operation and Maintenance efforts include but are not limited to: water native plants during establishment, remove nonnative and noxious weeds, if spraying noxious weeds this shall be done on a spot basis to protect forbs and legumes that benefit native pollinators and other wildlife, replace plants or re-vegetate as needed to ensure ground is covered and soil is not exposed.

Please list what maintenance methods you will be using:

*Operation and Maintenance is required for at least 10 years after project installation. If applicant fails to establish, operate, or maintain their project, they are liable for 100% of the amount of financial assistance that was received to install and establish the practice. Any evidence of a problem occurring with the project should be reported immediately. Staff will complete occasional inspections. Inspections may be on site review, or through communication with the applicant.*
